<b>Your right to withdraw consent</b>	Where you or your guarantor has given consent, you or they have the right to withdraw that consent at any time. If you or they do, it will not affect the lawfulness of any processing for which we had consent prior to it being withdrawn.
<b>Location of your personal data</b>	We will normally keep your personal data and that of your guarantor within the United Kingdom or the European Economic Area.
<b>How long we will keep your personal data for</b>	We will normally keep personal data for you and the guarantor in line with the terms and conditions of your award contract. After this time period we will anonymise the personal information and keep it for analysis of engagement trends.
<b>Your rights in respect of your personal data</b>	You and the guarantor each have the right of access to your / their personal data and, in some cases, to require us to restrict, erase or rectify it or to object to our processing it, and the right of data portability.
